

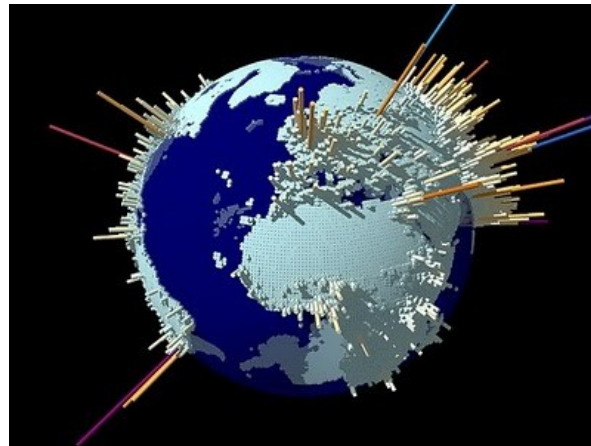


Data Visualization
